1 (Hearing began at 1:00 p.m.) 2 3 PROCEEDINGS 4 5 MR. BEATTY: Good afternoon everyone. This 6 is a public hearing on proposed amendments to 7 administrative rules titled, "Criminal Justice Information Systems." This hearing is conducted on 8 9 behalf of the Michigan Department of State Police, 10 pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act of 1969. 11 My name is Steve Beatty. I am the Regulatory Affairs 12 Officer at the department and will be facilitating the 13 hearing today. 14 This hearing is called to order at 1:00 15 p.m., on November 19, 2020, and is taking place at the 16 Michigan State Police Headquarters located at 7150 17 Harris Drive, Dimondale, Michigan, while utilizing appropriate social distancing protocols. This hearing 18 19 was published in three newspapers of general 20 circulation, as well as the Michigan Register, issue 21 #20, published on November 15, 2020. 22 Additionally, to provide an opportunity for 23 individuals to participate without having to appear in 24 person at the public hearing, the department's public 25 notices provided a web link to enable any interested

person to participate virtually through a Microsoft
 Teams meeting.

The department appreciates your patience regarding the virtual nature of this hearing. To ensure that an accurate record can be created and public comments are heard, we ask that persons participating remotely, please mute your microphones when you are not speaking to reduce background noise and to hear other speakers.

10 We will admit individuals as they enter the 11 We will call on each individual who has hearing. 12 entered a name to determine whether they would like to 13 speak. If you choose to speak, please state your name 14 and spell your name; indicate whether you are 15 representing a particular organization and identify 16 that organization; and state your email address and mailing address. If you are called on and do not wish 17 18 to speak, simply let us know.

We will then ask whether there are any other individuals in attendance who wish to speak. provided on the notice for this public hearing. 1 The 2 department is accepting written comments until 5:00 3 p.m., Eastern Time, today, November 19, 2020. 4 We will now begin calling on individuals to 5 see if they would like to make a public comment. 6 Richard Chaffee has joined us virtually via 7 Mr. Chaffee, do you wish to make a public Teams. 8 comment? 9 MR. CHAFFEE: No. I'll be observing only 10 and I do not wish to make a comment. 11 MR. BEATTY: Thank you. Wane Aldrich, I see you appearing virtually. 12 13 Do you wish to make a public comment? 14 MR. ALDRICH: No, sir. I'm just here to 15 observe. Thank you. 16 MR.
