SIZE CLASSIFICATION RULES

(By authority conferred on the liquor control commission by section 3 of the Initiated Law of 1976, being S445.573 of the Michigan Compiled Laws)

R 445.1 Definitions.

- Rule 1. (1) As used in these rules "act" means the Initiated Law of 1976, being S445.571 et seq. of the Michigan Compiled Laws.
- (2) The terms defined in the act have the same meaning when used in these rules, unless otherwise indicated.

R 445.3 Size classifications.

- Rule 3. (1) The commission may certify beverage containers for beverages other than beer, ale, or other malt drink of whatever alcoholic content.
- (2) The commission may certify beverage containers in 1 of the following size classifications; 7 oz.; 12 oz.; 16 oz.; 32 oz.; 64 oz.; 128 oz.; 2 liters.
- (3) Additional size classifications may be certified if the beverage container is in compliance with section 2(7) and section 3(2), (3), and (4) of the act.
