cording, disclosure, or distribution of data relating to a nonopioid directive
form or the transmission of a nonopioid directive form that complies with
state and federal confidentiality and consent laws, rules, and regulations.

By authority conferred on the Department of Health and Human Services by
sections 2226, 2233, and 9145 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
333.2226, 333.2233, and 333.9145. These rules will take effect 30 days after filing
with the Secretary of State. The rules (Rule Set 2019-045HS) are published on



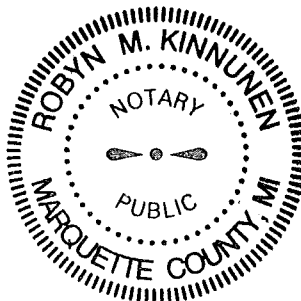

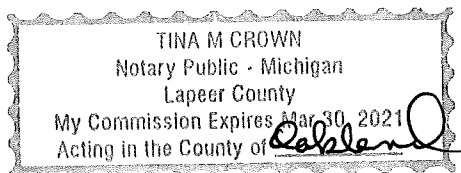
