The Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on proposed changes to the Barbers – General Rules rule set.

The proposed rules include the following changes: approve and adopt examination requirements for licensure; clarify requirements for licensure by endorsement; amend the requirements for relicensure; revise and update sanitation standards; revise and update standards pertaining to astringents, treatments of the eye, and blood spill procedures; revise the construction standards and equipment requirements for barber colleges; revise and update the duties of a barber college and add duties for a barbershop conducting an apprenticeship program; add a distance education rule; revise the curriculum requirements for a barber college and add the curriculum requirements for an apprenticeship program; and revise the rule related to student records and add requirements for apprenticeship records.
