This is public hearing on proposed administrative rules entitled "Genetic Counseling - General Rules", "Medicine - General Rules", and "Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery - General Rules". We are conducting this hearing under the authority of the Administrative Procedures Act, Public Act 306 of 1969, on be behalf of the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, Bureau of Professional Licensing.

7	colleagues and my fellow residents within my own program
8	as well as my own interest in getting the rule changed
9	for medicine licensure to be one year to be equivocal to
10	their D.O. counterparts.
