- 4 and I am an analyst for the Bureau of Community and Health
- 5 Systems in the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs.
- This hearing, regarding the Administrative Rules for
- 7 the Homes for the Aged, is being called to order at 9 a.m. on
- 8 August 18 in the G. Mennen Williams Building auditorium
- 9 located at 525 West Ottawa Street in Lansing, Michigan. The
- 10 hearing is being conducted under the authority of the
- 11 Administrative Procedures Act, P.A. 306 of 1969.
- The notice of public hearing was published in three
- 13 newspapers: on July 26 in the Flint Journal; July 27th in the
- 14 Grand Rapids Press; and July 28th in the Marquette Mining
- 15 Journal. The same notice was published in the Michigan
- 16 Register on August 15, 2022.
- 17 As stated in the notice, the proposed new rules
- 18 establish requirements for state licensed homes for the aged
- 19 providers to record, track, and respond to incidents where a
- 20 resident is harmed. These documents must be available to the
- 21 Department upon request during routine inspections or
- 22 complaint investigations.
- 23 Regulatory Impact Statements are available for
- 24 further explanation of these rule sets. Copies are available
- in the hall outside of the auditorium, or they can be found on



- 1 the website for the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings
- 2 and Rules.
- 3 Pursuant to section 45 of the Administrative
- 4 Procedures Act, MCL 24.245, the public hearing is an
- 5 opportunity for the public to present data, views, questions
- 6 and arguments regarding the proposed rules.
- 7 The Department will use the testimony and documents
- 8 presented at this hearing to determine if any changes should
- 9 be made to the proposed rules before they are adopted. If you
- 10 have comments, please make sure they relate directly to the
- 11 proposed rules. If you have questions regarding the rules,
- 12 please submit your questions as part of your testimony. If
- 13 you have suggested changes to the proposed rules, please
- 14 include the specific reasons why the changes would be in the
- 15 public interest.
- If you wish to comment, please complete a white
- 17 card, available when you came in, and submit it to me. This
- 18 will help the Department prepare the hearing record. When you
- 19 testify, please identify yourself by name and organization, if
- 20 any, that you may be speaking for today.
- Written statements may be submitted directly to me.
- 22 The Department will also accept written statements emailed or
- 23 postmarked until 5 p.m. on August 18th. Address information
- 24 can be found on the notice for the public hearing that we have
- 25 made available in the hall.

- Before we start the public comments, I invite
- 11 Heather Hosey to the podium -- I invite Larry Horvath to the

- MR. HORVATH: My name is Larry Horvath with the
- 14 Bureau of Community Health Systems. I just want to do a brief
- 15 update on the proposed changes to the administrative rules.
- The proposed changes were a result of our
- 17 communication with the provider community and their
- 18 associations and the interest for regulatory relief and
- 19 regulatory burden reduction. The proposed rules will allow
- 20 for continued reporting of incidents, but these reports will
- 21 now be maintained at the provider and available upon request
- 22 by the Department or during an inspection and investigation.
- This rule still requires that the providers maintain
- 24 a record of an incident and to take action to correct any
- 25 possible deficient practice, if identified during their
