21 MRS' administrative rules are being amended to 22 update definitions to align with Federal regulations and 23 provide clarity, modify the general requirements and 24 non-discrimination statement, capture the Agency's 25 process for developing a fee schedule for standardized rates of payment, and to bring the rules into conformity with current practice regarding post-employment services. Full copies of the proposed administrative rule changes, notice of public hearing, and regulatory impact statement are available at the front of the room and upon request. This public hearing is being conducted pursuant to provisions of 34 CFR 361.10(c) and 34 CFR 361.20.
